If your symposium is accepted the proposer will be expected to send an abstract of each speaker's talk to John Brebner.

1. A title for the symposium and the proposer's name, affiliation and contact details.
2. A 200 word (maximum) outline of the topic, its relevance and importance to the conference.
3. (a) Names of proposed speakers (maximum of 5)
(b) Titles of the speakers' talks
(c) Name of Chairman and Discussant if applicable

The deadline for symposia proposals is 30th November, 2004.

You will be informed whether the symposium has been accepted during January, 2005.

Failure to register for ISSID 2005 will revoke the acceptance of a symposium or part of it.

How to submit an abstract for a paper or poster For ISSID 2005 at Adelaide

Please state whether offering a paper or poster. Abstracts of 200 words (maximum) should be sent by email as standard text in the body of the email message (not as an attachment) to john.brebner@psychology.adelaide.edu.au

Abstracts should have a title, author(s)' names and their affiliation(s). The abstract should be specific about the aim and outcome of the research, and preferably should indicate the method used. To help the selection committee the abstract should conclude with the importance of the results obtained. Theoretical or other papers may require a different format but should not exceed 200 words.

The deadline for abstracts of papers or posters is 31st December, 2004

You will be informed by email before the end of February 2005 if your paper or poster has been accepted.

Failure to register for ISSID 2005 will revoke the acceptance of papers or posters.
